Float plane landing on Boot Lake — Recently in one day a float plane landed and took off several times and buzzed the area. Some lake residents were concerned about the closeness of the plane to boats and the amount of boat traffic on the lake at the time. Craig Kulla reported these Minnesota regulations: *Approaches and Takeoffs: All approaches and takeoffs from the water area shall be made in such a manner as to clear all structures on the land by at least 100 feet, and wherever the area of the body of water will permit, such landings and takeoffs shall be made at a distance of not less than 300 feet, both laterally and vertically, from any boat or person on the surface of the water, or as near to 300 feet as the area of the water will permit. (Minnesota Rules 8800.2700)

Fred will put information in the fall newsletter.*

A request was received from a Property Owner asking if the Association would send an Email advertising some merchandise for sale. We agreed that this was ok.

Teri being new to the area wondered if there was a defibrillator maintained anywhere in the area. This issue was addressed several years ago by the Association. Craig Nieman will contact Leonard Thelen who is a First Responder to find out what the current situation is.
